June 2007 – Rotary Centennial Park complete

Construction of the park/rest area in partnership with the Rotary Club of Corner Brook is now complete. Rotary has contributed to this project to commemorate both the 50 year anniversary of the club in Corner Brook and the Rotary International 100th anniversary in 2006. This beautifully landscaped area in the downtown also serves as a trailhead for the CBSDC trail network and incorporates an information kiosk complete with maps and information on trail attractions and other amenities to be found around the city.

Work began last fall and continued this spring with the finishing touches complete in early June. The area features the trademark CBSDC pavers and stone work, combined with multiple planting beds and a picnic area for folks who want to enjoy a lunch break outdoors.

The park was officially opened at a ceremony on September 21st by visiting Rotary District Governor Bette Douglas.
